PROBLEM STATEMENT

Providing education to our staff and providers on Maternal Sepsis

FOCUS AREA

Updating our hospital wide sepsis screening process to be specific to maternal sepsis in those who are pregnant/have recently given birth

- Lack of knowledge on Maternal Sepsis
- Screening tool specific for Maternal Sepsis – work in progress
- Maternal Education on POST-BIRTH Warning Signs

STATUS

- All clinical staff assigned sepsis education on healthcare on Net-Learning
- All patients receive POST-BIRTH Warning Signs handouts and verbal education from nursing staff

KEY INTERVENTIONS

Key Interventions:

- Implementing Patient Education on POST-BIRTH Warning Signs in each patient room
- Hiring a Sepsis Coordinator for our Hospital starting May 2026

MEASURES

- Current Sepsis Screening on Admission and every 8 hours
- No Definite Risk, Sepsis Risk, Severe Sepsis Risk

RESULTS

- Education fully implemented for our OB staff regarding Sepsis
