  - Create small tests of change
  - Identify key stakeholders

  - Establish timelines and due dates
  - Meet regularly to evaluate progress
- Peer-to-peer discussion
  - Early lessons learned from hospitals who started implementing UMWS education before the sprint
  - Sharing plans from PDSAs
  - Addressing persistent concerns or barriers

- Begin training staff on new or updated UMWS education and related workflow
